

ASPECT is a Horizon Europe Research and Innovation Action that will produce and improve seamless climate predictions covering the next 30 years and will embed these predictions into societally important climate change adaptation decisions over a range of sectors, time scales, spatial scales and decision making levels.

ASPECT will provide a delivery system for climate prediction information tailored taking into account user requirements.
